Dealers Required to Record Net Selling Price

Recently the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles (DHSMV) and the Department of Revenue (DOR) met to discuss process enhancements. They reviewed the current process of using the Florida Real-Time Vehicle Information System (FRVIS) and the Electronic Filing System (EFS) to capture dealer sales tax while issuing titles and registrations.

The Department of Revenue requested that the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles modify the FRVIS and EFS systems to require dealers to enter the net selling price prior to the completion of a title transaction. Currently fields are available to provide this

information; however, doing so is not mandatory. The proposed change will make entering the net selling price mandatory, and DHSMV will share this data with DOR.

Gathering and sharing this information will allow the Department of Revenue (DOR) to create efficiencies in its dealer sales tax administration process. DHSMV plans to roll out this change in late June.

We look forward to working with you on this initiative to ensure its smooth implementation.

Calendar of Events

May

- July birthmonth motor vehicle renewals mailed on the 25th of May
- Office Closed – Memorial Day – Monday May 28
- Delinquent real estate taxes advertised for 3 consecutive weeks prior to tax certificate sale.
- Delinquent tangible personal property taxes advertised one time
- Online tax certificate sale site becomes available
- Online property tax payment by credit card & e-check ends 2-3 days prior to tax certificate sale
- Payment of current year property tax by wire funds transfer ends 2-3 days prior to tax certificate sale
- Tax certificate sale for delinquent real estate taxes begins on or before June 1; for the 2012 sale, certificate batches will begin closing 5/26/12
- June quarterly installment bills mailed last business day of May

Providing Secure Forms to Participating Dealers

ADP Dealer Services, Inc. (ADP) provides an electronic library of various forms for their dealer customers. Recently ADP worked in partnership with the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles to explore the option of providing some secure forms online. The 82994, Motor Vehicle Title Reassignment Supplement, and the 82995, Motor Vehicle Power of Attorney/Odometer Disclosure would be printed using their Finance & Insurance (F&I) Digital Contracting Solution.

The Department and ADP entered into a contract which authorizes ADP to issue

forms 82994 and 82995 with its Laser Station document printers, software, and secure bonded paper. Participating dealers will be able to produce accurate paper reproductions of these forms. No blank copies of these digital forms will need to be stored at the dealership because a form will print during a retail sale when required.

The Department is looking forward to all participants mutually benefiting from this new process and to eventually saving money as fewer forms will be manufactured and shipped.
